Dive Instructor MANAGEMENT Traineeship – 17 weeks

General Information

This is a comprehensive package of professional dive training at the IDC College/ PRO DIVE Academy in Marbella, leading to PADI's Master Scuba Diver Trainer award and worldwide job opportunities. This traineeship follows the well-established PADI modular programme starting with Advanced Open Water Diver. It includes a list of specialty courses to ensure you are competent in all areas of dive operation.

The traineeship includes a dive-away experience - a two weeks period after your Divemaster assessment, where you log more dives, gain experience and take your first steps as a dive professional. In the first week you assist on dive courses in Marbella. In the second week you travel to the Costa del la Luz at the Atlantic Ocean for a week, diving in paradise; accommodation included.

After dive-away, you return to Marbella to take part in the DSD leader course. Next you join your Instructor Development Course (IDC). This is designed to teach you all you need to know about dive training within the PADI scheme, as well as preparing you for the specific job of teaching the sport. This is followed by PRO DIVE's IDC Plus, where you recap the essential skills, practise your teaching techniques and undertake a mock exam. A short period of revision and practical rehearsal ensures you are ready to pass your Instructor Examination with flying colours.

The final four weeks of the traineeship are spent on a Graduate Dive Management programme, where you add to your list of professional qualifications towards your rating of PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer.

General Information

It includes a list of specialty courses to ensure you are competent in all areas of dive operation plus a four weeks development phase after graduation, to give you confidence, experience and credits as a dive instructor.

The traineeship includes a dive-away experience - a two weeks period after your Divemaster assessment, where you log more dives, gain experience and take your first steps as a dive professional. In the first week you assist on dive courses in Marbella. In the second week you travel to the Costa del la Luz at the Atlantic Ocea for a week, diving in paradise; accommodation included.

After dive-away, you return to Marbella to take part in the DSD leader course. Next you join your Instructor Development Course (IDC).
