Divemaster PRO (Fast Track) Traineeship – 6 weeks

General Information

This is an extensive package of professional dive training at the IDC College/ PRO DIVE Academy in Marbella, leading to PADI's Divemaster qualification, a passport to worldwide job opportunities. A Divemaster rating is the basic qualification required for professional work in the recreational dive industry. This traineeship follows the well-established PADI modular training system, starting with Open Water Diver. It includes a list of specialty courses to ensure you are competent in all areas of dive operation to that level.

This Fast-Track programme omits the work experience that is a highlight of the 8-Weeks PRO Divemaster Traineeship.

Work experience is a period after your Divemaster assessment where you log more dives, gain experience and take your first steps as a dive professional. In the first week, you assist on dive courses in Marbella. In the second week you travel to the Costa de la Luz at the Atlantic Ocean for a week, diving in paradise. See the 8-Week PRO Divemaster Traineeship if you want to include a dive away in your programme.

Requirements

- **Must provide** your own mask, snorkel and fins.
- **Scuba equipment hire** on request. Must provide all your own equipment. (Special hire package available for the 6 weeks at 450 €. Unbeatable package deals available on new equipment purchases).
- **A dive medical** must be completed by a qualified diving doctor. Diving medical fees range from 40 €. (Note: a history of asthma and some other conditions may exclude you from scuba diving).
- **Minimum age** 18 years, no maximum.
